Alcoa Tenn Federal Credit Union Scholarship Fund

This scholarship application must be used by any student wishing to apply for an Alcoa Tenn Federal Credit Union Scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY

The Alcoa Tenn Federal Credit Union Scholarship Fund is open to any High School graduating student from Alcoa H.S., Heritage HS, Maryville HS, Maryville Christian School H.S., William Blount High School, Greenback High School, or any Blount County Home Schooled Senior who plans to continue their education, either as a college/ university student, nursing or other medical fields, or technical/trade schools.

- Applicants must be a High School Senior or Home Schooled Senior.
- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 (or Home Schooled Equivalent) through the current fall semester.
- Applicants must be planning to continue their education or certified vocational or technical program as a full-time student in the fall of the year the award is made with a goal of earning a recognized undergraduate academic degree or certificate in the time normally prescribed for the attainment of said degree.

QUALIFYING INSTITUTIONS

Awards are given for undergraduate work only.

- Scholarship recipients may attend any accredited, public or Private, 2- or 4-year college, university, or technical school in the United States or certified vocational or technical school.
- Any changes in plans for college, after notification of receipt of scholarship, must be given in writing to the President/CEO or his/her designee.

AWARDS

- Effective with the fall of year the award is made, unless the student(s) program begins earlier. Six scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each will be awarded annually to the deserving senior from each of the six high schools: Alcoa, Heritage, Maryville, Maryville Christian School, William Blount High School, and Greenback High School. One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to a deserving Home Schooled student in Blount County.
- The principal at each school will determine and select the recipient of the scholarship, and the principal will notify Alcoa Tenn Federal Credit Union of their selection. The Home Schooled scholarship recipient will be selected by an independent committee approved by the President/CEO of Alcoa Tenn Federal Credit Union.
- Funds are available for tuition, books, room and board.
- Checks will be written upon receipt by the President/CEO or his/her designee, of a copy of a bill or Certification of Enrollment form from the college. Checks are made payable to, and mailed directly to the college/school. The President/CEO or his/her designee will provide the college/school with a list of scholarship recipients by name, social security number, award amounts and method of payment.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATION PACKET:

1. Complete **ALL** fields required in this application.
2. Have your high school counselor or high school submit a copy of your **transcript** through the current fall semester. (If you are a high school senior, your transcript must reflect a cumulative GPA through the current fall semester.) Home Schooled students must also submit equivalent transcripts which may include standard testing results.
3. Have a high school teacher write a Letter of Recommendation on your behalf and submit it to the school principal. Home Schooled students should submit a letter of recommendation from equivalent teacher, counselor, or professional.
4. Submit a one-page **essay**. Briefly describe yourself. This may include your strengths and your most important achievements in school and in your community. You may also include your hobbies, interests, sports, volunteer work, and employment.
