On March 30th, the spotlight was on Alcoa Tenn Federal Credit Union for its 81st Annual Meeting. More than 300 members assembled at Alcoa High School to share a great meal, a glowing fiscal report, and some positive plans for the future.

The event took on a special shine with Alcoa Tenn's Chuck Sayne as emcee. Board members provided reports on credit union operations, and three members, Bob Sowders, Al Cage, and Carl Guider, were re-elected to three-year terms. Good humor and door prizes were sprinkled in with the business.

The featured guest speaker this year was Greg McClain, Maryville City Manager, who shared his slide presentation of and fascination with Blount County history with the crowd. He highlighted several familiar landmarks and events in Maryville, Alcoa, and nearby Smoky Mountains.

"The mountains are a real thread through our history and everything that we do," he said.

The focus then turned to the special people of the present. Volunteer and Board member Bob Sowders was honored as the Ronald C. Manges Memorial Award recipient. Sowders, an Alcoa, Inc. retiree, continues to give of his time and talent, not only as an ATFCU Board member, but also and as a trainer at the aluminum plant, a Blount County Rescue Squad volunteer, and Red Cross instructor. But he added that ATFCU really shines in the way it has helped its members face personal fiscal challenges. "Those are the things that made us get through 81 years," Proffitt said.

The 2017 Annual Meeting may now be over for this year, but the credit union remains a beacon in serving its members far into the future.
















2017 Franklin E. Robinson Memorial Award
