Dalton Fiegle, Grandson of Jim Fiegle Accepts Summer Position at Alcoa Tenn

There's no denying the everlasting legacy of Jim Fiegle, Alcoa Tenn's former CFO who inspired many and helped pave the way for the credit union to flourish well into the 21st century. While Jim is sadly no longer with us, many Staff

continue to ask the question, "what would Jim do?" when faced with a challenge. For Dalton Fiegle, it's a question he intends to live out the answer to.

A Finance major attending the University of Tennessee, Dalton was hired for the summer as a teller at the Main Office in hopes of gaining some work experience in his chosen career path. When he applied for the position, he knew much would be expected of



him at Alcoa Tenn and that this would be an excellent opportunity to work toward the level of excellence his grandfather was known for. "That was the first thing I thought of," Fiegle stated. "I knew they would recognize the name; however,

it was very important to me that I succeed on my own merit."

Dalton remembers his grandfather as a man who exemplified the same level of hard work, dedication and care in his family life as he did in his professional life. "He was always working around the house, building things and tending to his garden. He taught me how to fish, and he always showed up to my ball games. Even if they

were out of state. He would also cook dinner for us every Sunday. He was definitely a leader in our family."

While at Alcoa Tenn, Dalton says he learned a few new banking concepts that he hadn't studied in school yet and gained a better understanding of the concepts he had studied. "It's one thing to learn about financial concepts in school but actually seeing it in practice puts it into a whole new perspective, which is beneficial to me."

He also went on to remark on the positive work and community culture here at the credit union. "I really like how close knit everyone is here. I didn't think it would be that way even though I had always heard it. You can tell everyone really cares about each other here."

It's that kind of culture that Dalton feels he would like to continue to serve in as it lines up perfectly with the type of influence his grandfather had on him. "I've always heard so much about him and how good of guy he was. I want to live up to that and to just strive to be a better person." Dalton is currently in is senior year at UT.
