Dalton Fiegle, Grandson of Jim Fiegle Accepts Summer Position at Alcoa Tenn

A Finance major attending the University of Tennessee, Dalton was hired for the summer as a teller at the Main Office in hopes of gaining some work experience in his chosen career path. When he applied for the position, he knew much would be expected of

While at Alcoa Tenn, Dalton says he learned a few new banking concepts that he hadn't studied in school yet and gained a better understanding of the concepts he had studied. "It's one thing to learn about financial concepts in school but actually seeing it in practice puts it into a whole new perspective, which is beneficial to me."
